New Beds for Casa Reom



Thanks to all those who donated to the Beds4Beira appeal, the new beds have started to be built at Casa Reom.

A new stronger style of frame has been made by a local welder, which should last longer and be easier to repair. Not only is this more sustainable but it supports local trades. With the appeal reaching 40% of its target almost half of the boys have new beds. There is still time to give at www.give.net/Beds4Beira.

Escola Reom Expands

The school at Casa Reom (Escola Reom) expanded at the beginning of this year and now caters for around 500 local children, both boys and girls. This has been achieved by an increase in teaching staff from 7 to 13 teachers. The increase in teachers now means that each teacher has a single class rather than trying to look after two classes each. The teacher's salaries are now paid for by the government with top-up expenses being provided by Casa Reom. The top-up ensures they attract and retain the best teachers. The teachers are contracted by the government but under the control of Escola Reom.



The extra teachers were recruited during a 'seminar' event at Inhamizua where prospective teachers were invited for tests and assessments to select the best candidates. This also involved sharing the Christian values of Casa Reom to ensure that the teachers were happy to work with the Jocum Beira staff.



Escola Reom continues to be a popular choice for local families because of its good quality of education that is accessible to those who can't afford the high fees that other schools charge.

New Classroom Block

To cope with the growth of Escola Reom work has begun on a new classroom block. This building work fits into the longer term plans for a multi-use building housing a kitchen, mess hall / meeting room, office and staff accommodation.
